Outdure QwickBuild is an aluminium subframe system for supporting decking boards, structure tiles and synthetic turf. QwickBuild offers a low height, long span, high load substructure framework (up to 5 kpa). QwickBuild is also used as a replacement for traditional timber substructures for any other decking application. QwickBuild has been designed to incorporate:

- Outdure range of composite decking, and other composite decking brands;
- Hardwood timber decking boards;
- Outdure range of exterior structural tiles and other structural tile brands; and
- Outdure synthetic turf.
