

Cut out the Vent Tray exhaust slot




Install the Vent Tray and air inlet grille

- Install the air inlet grille (option).
- Seat the vent tray plinth in position on the cupboard floor.
- Secure with the 4 screws supplied.
- Fit the Exhaust duct, secure with 2 screws supplied.

Cleaning and general maintenance

Wipe surfaces with a damp cloth and then wipe drv with a clean, dry cloth. Do not use disinfectant sprays without wiping dry afterwards.



The V

The Vent Tray must be fitted, it provides an essential safety function in case of refrigeration system failure.

> Read the instructions supplied with the vent kit , prior to installation of the Vent Tray.

All dimensions in these instructions are in mm.

Tools needed for installation (not supplied)

In addition to normal tools, the following (or equivalent equipment) will be required.

- Jig saw or oscillating tool for vent cut-outs.
- 12mm diameter drill for vent cut-out corners.



Be aware of the risks of hazards which could cause harm when using tools. Assess the risks before starting the installation.


Parts supplied in the kit

Qty	Description
1	Vent tray plinth
1	Exhaust duct
4	Vent tray plinth mounting screws (large)
2	Adjustable exhaust duct mounting screws (small)


Vent tray dimensions

Allow 520mm for depth, 500mm width, 40mm height (height above cabinet floor).






- Assemble the two parts of the vent tray.
- The depth of the tray may be adjusted by up to 50mm, to suit the depth of the HydroTap.
- Use the alignment marks to ensure the exhaust duct fits square on the vent tray plinth.



2 Positioning


- Observe the clearance envelope (below).
- Position the Tap and The Command centre as close together as possible.






Plan the ventilation slots

- Choose an inlet vent option, plan the vent placement.
- Observe 100mm Inlet Exhaust vent separation.
