Matai – *Podocarpus spicatus*

Other Names: Black Pine

Region of Origin: New Zealand

SPECIES OVERVIEW:

Heart Matai is a straw to chestnut yellow, with an occasional reddish tinge and even colour. The narrow sapwood is white and easily distinguished. Texture is uniform, fine and even with a straight grain and moderate lustre.

MAIN USES:

Typically used in flooring, furniture and cabinetmaking and interior joinery.

WORKING PROPERTIES:

Heartwood machines excellently but when dry requires pre-boring for nailing. Steam bending properties moderately good.

MECHANICAL PROPERTIES:

Good strength properties especially in compression. It is relatively hard.

AVAILABILITY:

Specifications stocked at Rosenfeld Kidson are:
