Initiated and endorsed by the New Zealand Government the certification also qualifies for a maximum credit rating for concrete materials under the Green Star NZ scheme facilitated by the New Zealand Green Building Council.









Environmental blend concrete must meet strict environmental criteria to achieve certification. Firth can supply environmental blend from three Auckland plants based in north, central and south Auckland. Customers using up to 90% of an environmental blend concrete can qualify for a maximum of 3 points under Green Star NZ for your building project.

Criteria the environmental blend is assessed on are:

- \rightarrow Manufacturing sites hold necessary consents and permits;
- \rightarrow Raw materials such as cement carry ECNZ certification;
- → Aggregate supplier hold necessary consents, permits and follow strict management plans;
- ightarrow Hazardous substances are managed as per HSNO Act:
- → Water and air discharges are monitored and managed;
- \rightarrow Water and solid waste recycling programs;
- ightarrow Energy management;
- ightarrow Employee training programs.
