Application Guide		
Surface Preparation	 All surfaces must be thoroughly cleaned and free of all loose dirt, dust, grease, loose or flaking paint, and loose surface plaster. Efflorescence or mould on masonry or concrete surfaces must be treated. Flatten gloss surfaces by thoroughly sanding and wipe clean with a damp cloth, then apply primer, sealer or undercoat as required. 	
Application	 Brush, roller, conventional or airless spray. 	
Procedure	• Stir contents thoroughly before and during use with a broad flat stirrer, using an upward lifting action.	
And	Brush/Roller: Rinse brush or roller in water before starting and use while still slightly damp.	
Equipment	Apply full even coats direct from the container. Under hot conditions or on very absorbent surfaces, up to 100ml clean water may be added per litre to assist application.	
	Airless/Conventional Spray: Suitable for application by all standard spray equipment. If necessary thin with up to 100ml per litre of water to aid atomisation.
