Classique Ply is a high-grade interior ply with excellent edge detail, with a Euro Poplar Populus spp. core and the option of American White Oak Quercus alba, Canadian Oak Quercus spp. or Euro Birch Betula pendula external veneer.

Beautiful, and light-weight, it is a popular choice for wall linings and joinery. (The option of using with HPL laminates is available.)

HANDLING & APPLICATION INFORMATION

Classique ply is a lighter weight timber than other plywoods, the highly visual surface will harden once a good quality lacquer is applied. Plywood is a natural product that can be affected by changes in weather conditions: moisture and temperature. Increased moisture content or temperature variation may cause internal stresses causing previously flat sheets to bow. At Plymasters, precautions are taken to minimize this. However, once the plywood has left our warehouse we cannot guarantee sheets to remain flat unless fastened. This is particularly important whene free standing kitchen/cabinet doors are concerned. When storing panels, stack on a firm raised base with enough support to prevent sagging. Cover the pallet to protect top and edges.
