



Wiring instruction and consumer operating instructions for the Cat 646E7 Digital timer.

Your digital timer is an accurate, electronic timing device which allows a load to be switched for a selected time interval. This unit allows 6 time settings over a 7 day period.





INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

The digital timer has a built in rechargeable battery. If a power failure occurs, the rechargeable battery will maintain the memory of the timer - avoiding the loss of any pre-set programmes. Note: This battery maybe run down when this product is installed. Connecting to mains power will recharge battery to enable storage of programmes.

CONTROLS

DAY Allows selection of the actual day switching operations as required.

Switching programmes options are:

- a) Select one day: Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday-Thursday-Friday-Saturday-Sunday
- b) Select Monday to Friday as noted at top of screen
- c) Select Saturday and Sunday as noted at top of screen
- d) Select Monday to Saturday as noted at top of screen
- e) Select everyday: Monday to Sunday as noted at top of screen.

PROG Allows On and Off times to be set and day selection to be performed.

TIME Allows "actual" time and day to be set and revert to read time display after performing setting functions.

HR Allows setting of hours during programming

MIN Allows setting of minutes during programming

MAN Override when timer is ON mode, press to override to OFF. When timer is in OFF mode, press to override to ON.

Note: After pressing override, the timer will automatically revert to programmed function at the next set time.

R Pressing this button will delete all programmed information from the memory. Initial programming - Press and release Reset

Avoid the use of sharp objects that could damage the rubber membrane.

TO SET ACTUAL TIME

Press and hold button marked 'TIME', use button marked 'DAY' to select the day today, use 'HR' and 'MIN' to programme the time, now check display screen for accuracy and release 'TIME' button.

TO SET ON/OFF TIMES

Press and release button marked 'PROG', screen will show

TIMER ON

Select the day of operation required by use of 'DAY' button. Set time On required, by use of 'HR' and 'MIN' buttons. Press and release 'PROG' button again, screen will show

Select the time that you wish the timer to switch OFF by use of 'DAY' 'HR' 'MIN' buttons.

Six 'On' and Six 'Off' times are available. Repeat above until the required number of time settings have been entered. Press and release 'TIME' button to revert to actual time display, your timer is now programmed to operate.

RANDOM FACILITY

Your timer features a 'RANDOM' setting by pressing 'DAY' and 'HR' together, the timer will switch ON and OFF completely at random, regardless of any stored programmes. To cancel the random mode, simply press 'DAY' and 'HR' together again.

Pressing this button will delete all programmed information from the memory. This function will only operate if one or more programmed switching commands are set.

FAULT FINDING

In the unlikely event that your timer does not perform satisfactorily, please check:

- 1. All programming has been correctly completed.
- 2. All connected loads are wired correctly and are not isolated.
- 3. Button 'Reset' has not been inadvertently pressed.
- 4. Timer has not been set to Random.

WARNING

Under no circumstances should you try to dismantle this product, DOING SO WILL INVALIDATE YOUR GUARANTEE. THERE ARE NO USER SERVICEABLE PARTS INSIDE.
